MEDTECH obtains the CE marking for its ROSA™ Spine robot.

MEDTECH (Euronext FR0010892950-ROSA) specialized in the design, development and marketing of surgical robots, announces the CE marking of its new product ROSA™Spine, a robotic assistant for minimally-invasive spine surgery.

This regulatory approval now allows the marketing of ROSA™Spine robot in Europe. The ROSA Spine robot is mainly dedicated to pedicle screw fixation procedures (over one million surgical procedures a year are performed worldwide).

The first ROSA™Spine surgical interventions have been successfully performed for the placement of pedicle screws. This type of intervention is often performed in the treatment of degenerative lumbar spine diseases. A monocentric pilot study was carried out to assess the accuracy provided by robotic guidance systems.
