## Medtech receives the 2014 « Revelation » prize in the Technology Fast 50 Awards for the Mediterranean area

Montpellier, France, November 07, 2014 – MEDTECH (Euronext, FR0010892950 – ROSA ) a company specializing in designing, developing and marketing innovative surgical assistance robots, is the 2014 « Révélation » prizewinner in the Mediterranean Deloitte Technology Fast 50 Awards.

The Technology Fast 50 Awards was created in 2001 by Deloitte, and rewards fast-growing technological companies who make strong progress in their financial results over 5 periods. There are national and regional categories, recognized by investors and customers as a genuine label. The 14th edition of the Mediterranean Area Awards involves 50 candidate companies.

The regional Technology Fast 50 2014 Jury chose to reward Medtech, not only for its excellent performance in increasing its sales figures, but also for its strong capacity for technological innovation.

Indeed, during its 2013/2014 financial period (ending June 30, 2014) Medtech made a revenue of 2.5 M€ and recorded a 42% progression in sales compared with the previous financial period.

As from October 30, 2014, the company now has a fleet of 30 ROSA™ robots installed throughout the world and over 1 700 interventions to its record. Also, Medtech has just launched the sale of its new ROSA™ Spine robot, designed for minimally invasive spine surgery. ROSA™ Spine is mainly destined for pedicle screw fixation. Over one million surgical procedures of this kind are performed in the world every year. ROSA™ Spine will be exhibited at the NASS (North American Spine Society) congress from November 12 to 14 in San Francisco, USA. This event gathers over 4 500 surgeons and the congress represents the world's gold standard in the field of spine surgery.

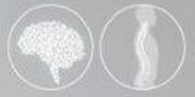

In 2007, MEDTECH developed ROSA™, a state-of-the-art technological device devoted to brain surgery procedures. ROSA™ has been approved in Europe, the United States and Canada.

In 2013 Medtech received the « European Company of the Year Award » in the "robotic neurosurgery" category from Frost & Sullivan.

In July 2014, MEDTECH obtained the CE marking for its new product ROSA™ Spine, a robotic- assistive device for minimally invasive surgery of the spine.
