Medtech Announces First Sale of ROSA Spine Robot in Europe

Montpellier, France, June 11 2015. MEDTECH (Euronext, FR0010892950 – ROSA), a company specialized in designing, developing and marketing innovative surgical robots, is pleased to announce the first sale of its ROSA™ Spine robot in Europe.

This first ROSA™ Spine robot was purchased by Amiens University Hospital in Amiens, France, a cutting-edge technology center for the treatment of brain and spine disorders. The neurosurgery department, led by Prof. Johann Peltier is renowned for its state-of-the-art equipment in imaging systems and robotics and its scientific work. The hospital already owns a ROSA™ Brain robot, which has been helping surgeons perform cranial surgery since 2011. Amiens University Hospital was also one of the very [first to use ROSA™ Spine](#) in clinical trials led by Doctors Anthony Fichten and Michel Lefranc a few months ago.

Bertin Nahum, President and Founder of Medtech commented: *“This first sale of ROSA™ Spine in Europe, just a few months after receiving market approval, is extremely encouraging and a clear example of the interest generated by our technology for treating brain and spine disorders. In the U.S., we remain on track for potential FDA clearance of ROSA Spine by the end of the year, which will allow us to build on the strong traction of ROSA Brain with U.S. hospitals and enter the largest market for spine procedures.”*
